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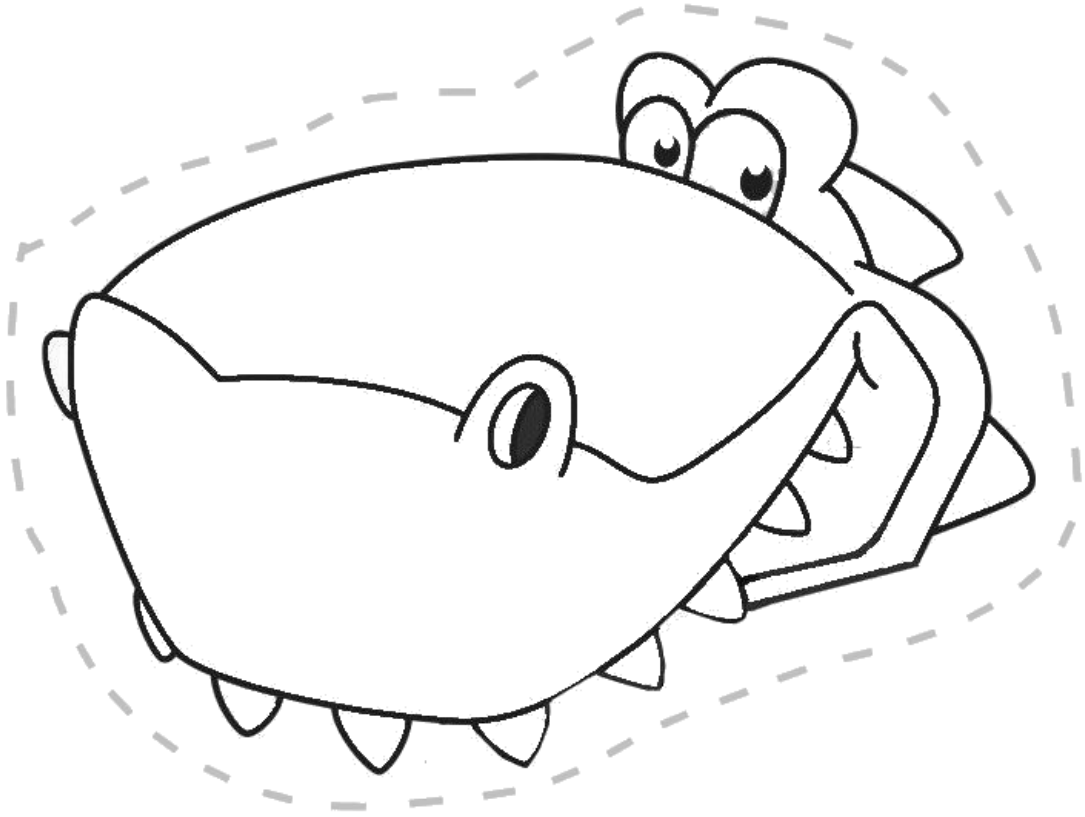
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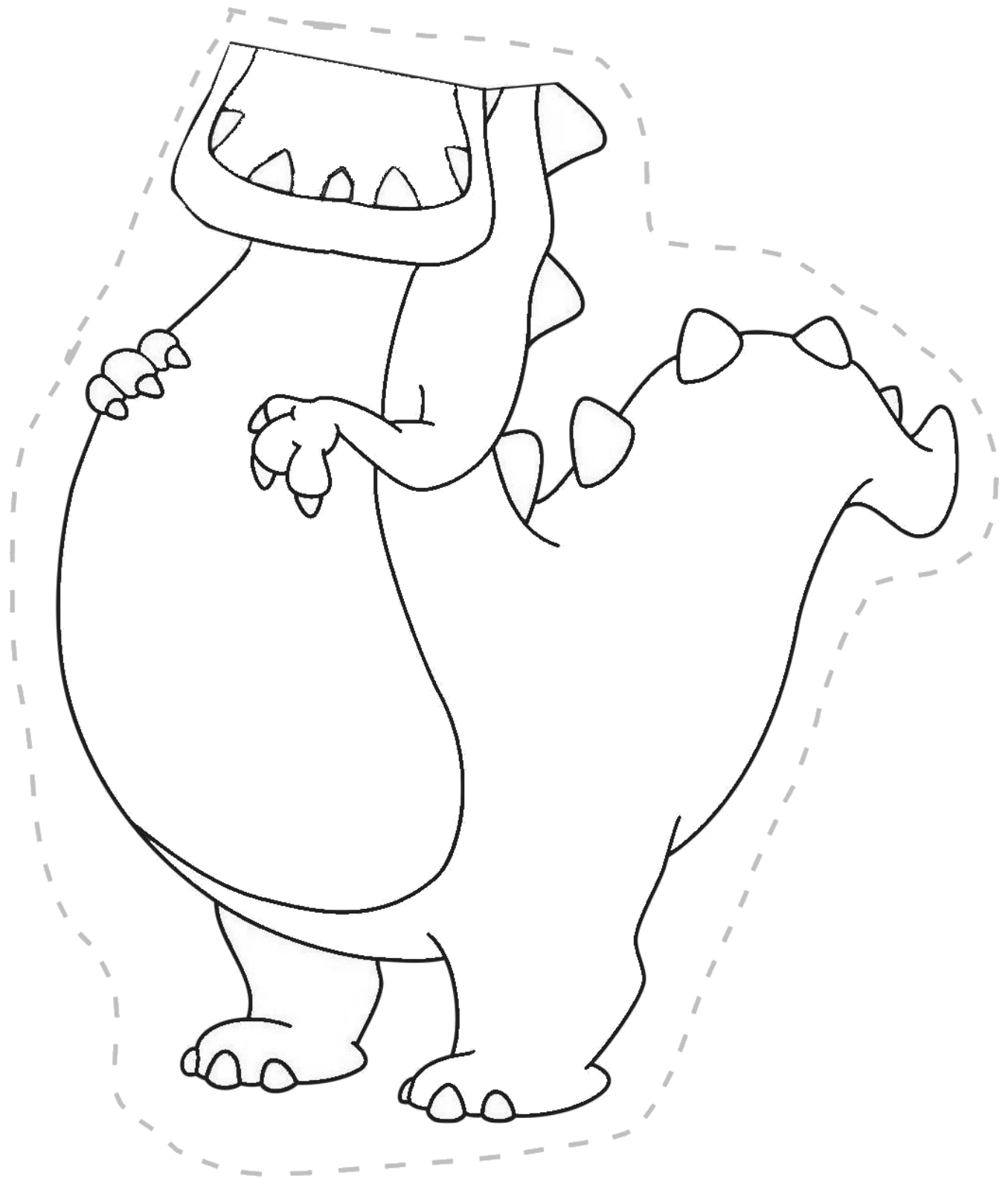
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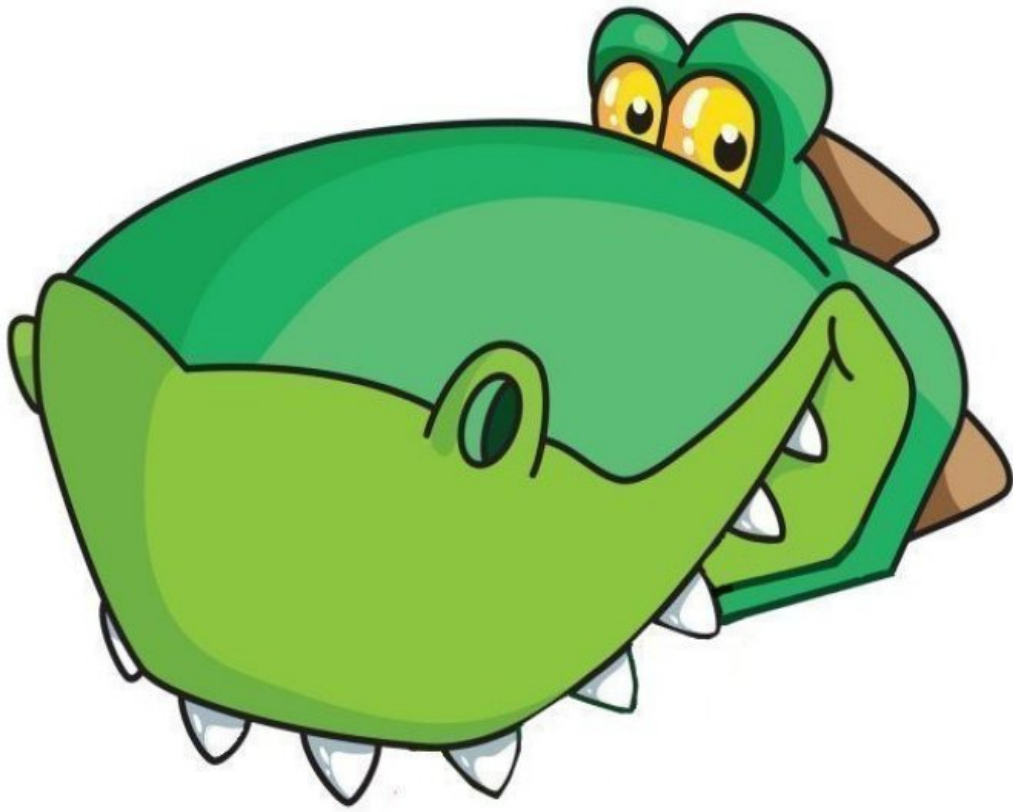
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Dinosaur Paper Bag Puppet









Dinosaur Paper Bag Puppet

Directions: Print out either the colored dinosaur or the black and white dinosaur onto heavy paper such as white cardstock paper, cut out.

If you are using the black and white dinosaur puppets, have the children in your group color their dinosaur. You will need either crayons or markers.

They may want to decorate the dinosaur with a few all circle stickers.

You will need a lunch sized paper bag and turn it upside down, tape or glue the head of the dinosaur to the bottom of the bag.

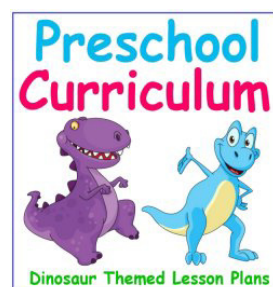
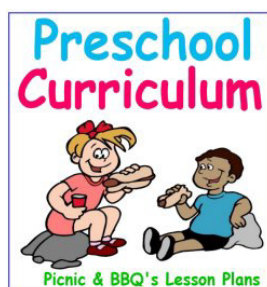
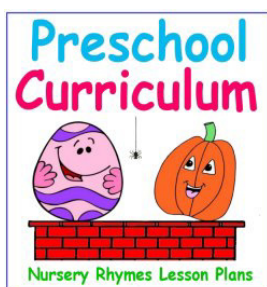
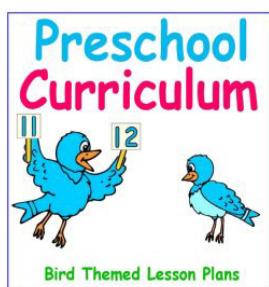
Lift up the flap of the bottom of the bag and tape or glue the bottom part of the dinosaur's mouth under the flap with the rest of the body being taped or glue to the bag.

When they are done, show the children how they can open the bag, place their hand inside and move their hand all the way to back of the paper bag and carefully move their hand inside the bag to make it look like the dinosaur is opening and closing his mouth.

Colored Dinosaur – Same directions as above, except the children will not have to color the dinosaur.
