Or place the story into a 3 ring folder to make a book.


Or place the story into a presentation book.

Read the story to the children.


The book is 20 pages long.

Have the printer start printing from page 3 to page 23.


Bluebird At The Beach






Bluebird flew around the entire beach until she saw something very colorful in the sand. She flew down to check it out. "Wow, Look what I found," she yelled to all of her friends.








Bluebird decided to fly around the beach some more to see what else she could color today.
