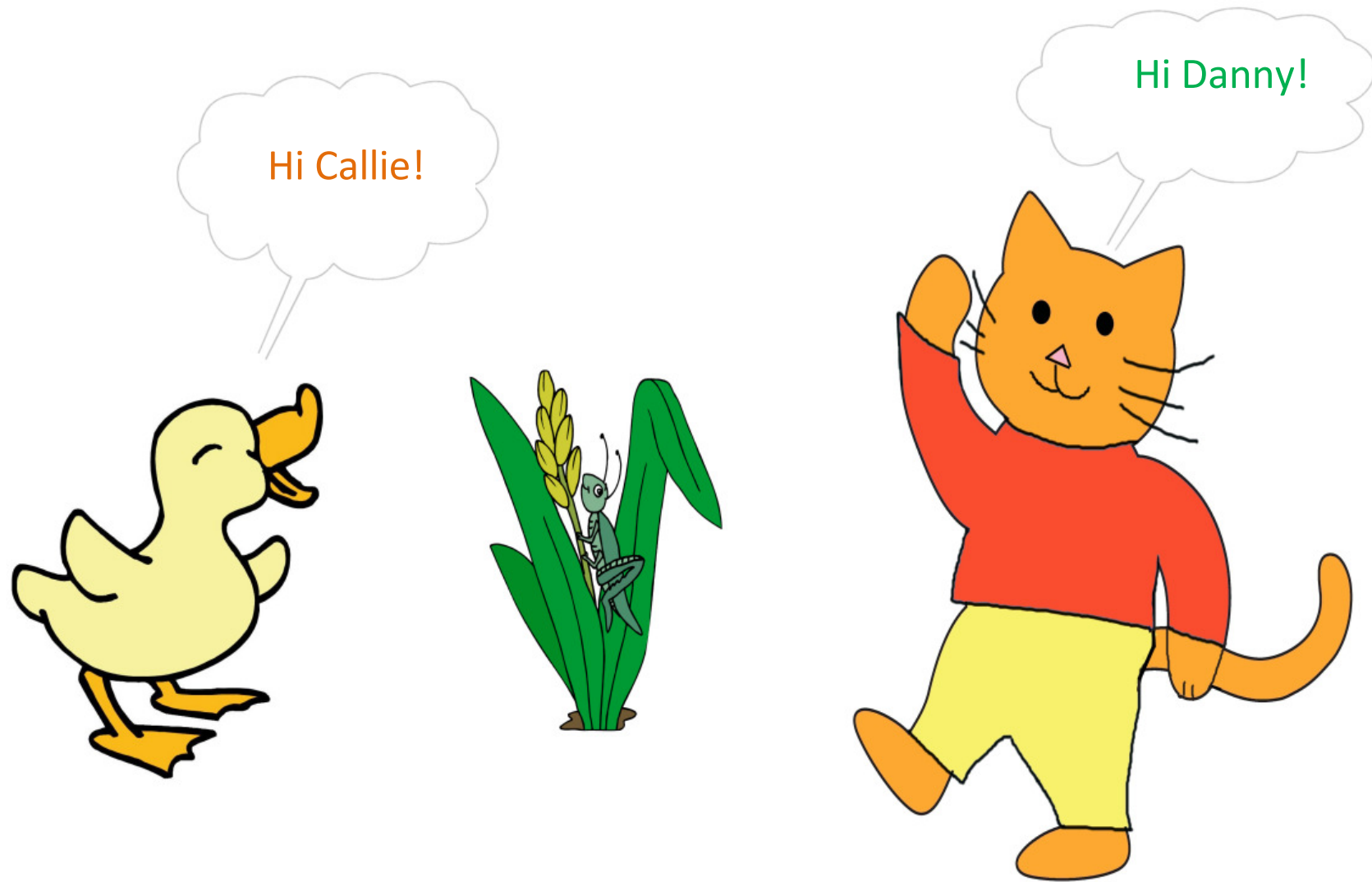

Is That A Caterpillar?

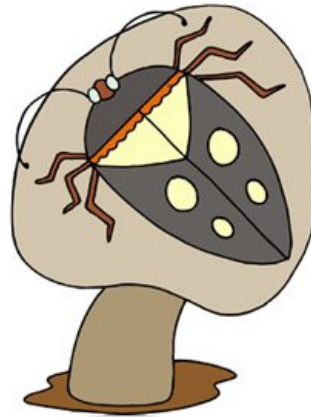




"What are you doing today?" Quacked Danny Duck.

"I want to find a caterpillar!"

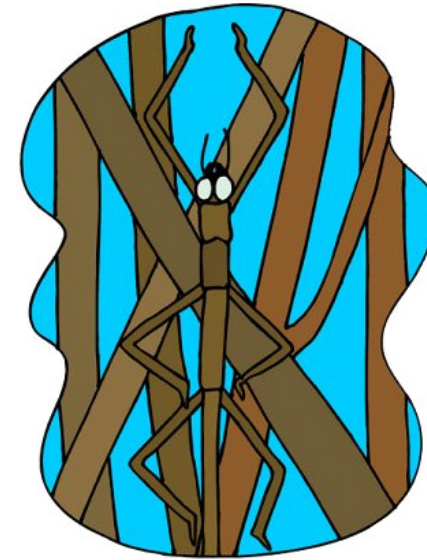
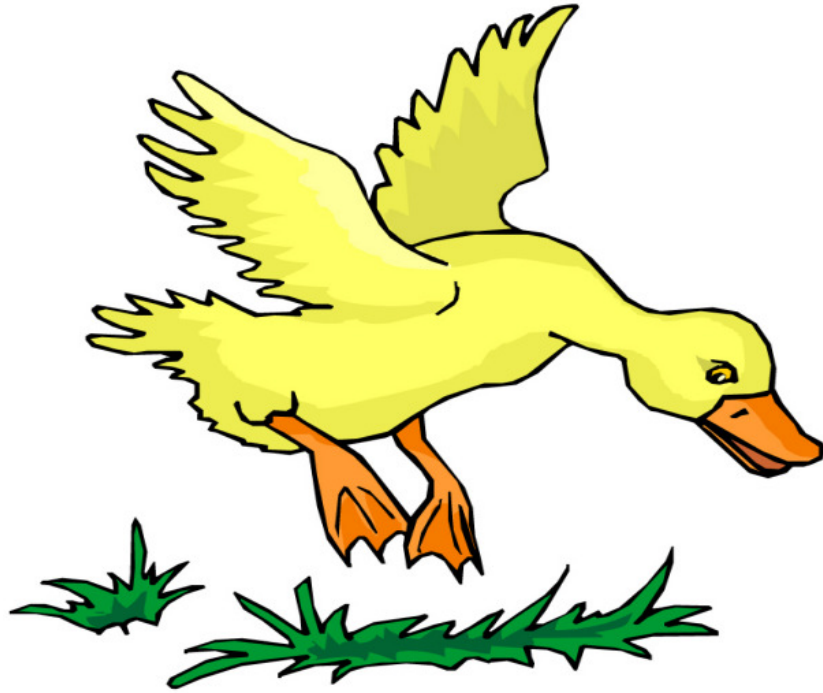
"Quack, Quack, that sounds like fun! Can I help you?" "Yes, let's go find a caterpillar!"

“I think the beetle is trying to hide from the mouse.”

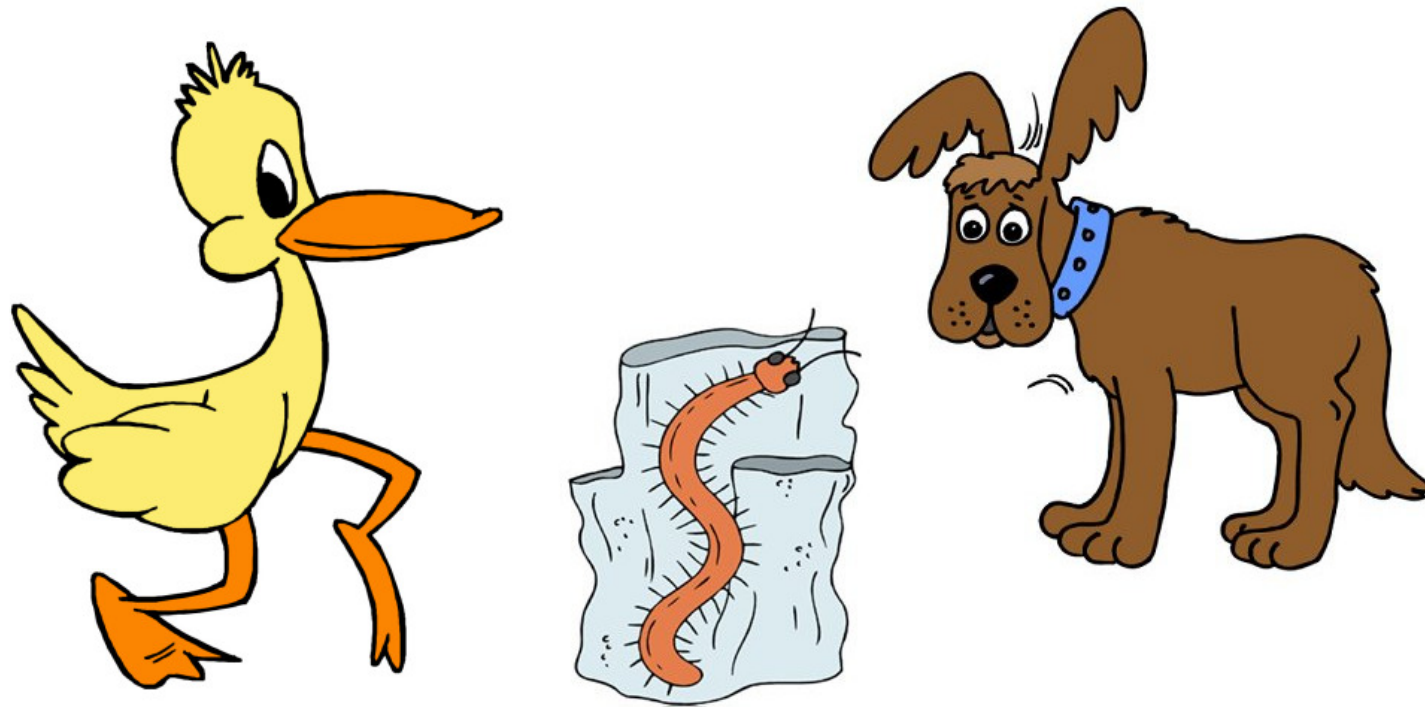


“Oh look Callie, is that a caterpillar?” Quacked Danny Duck.

“It’s hiding, look again, do you see it now?”

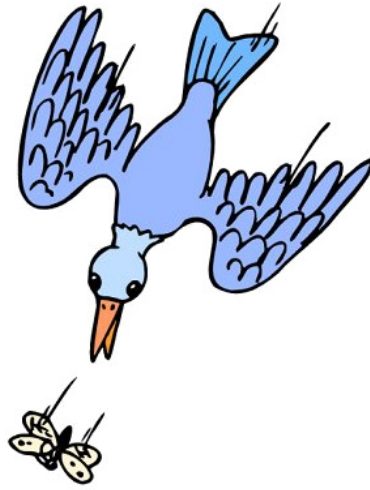
“Oh, there it is, good eyes duck! But, that’s not a caterpillar it’s a walking stick!”

“Ruff, ruff, barked the dog, look at all those legs?”



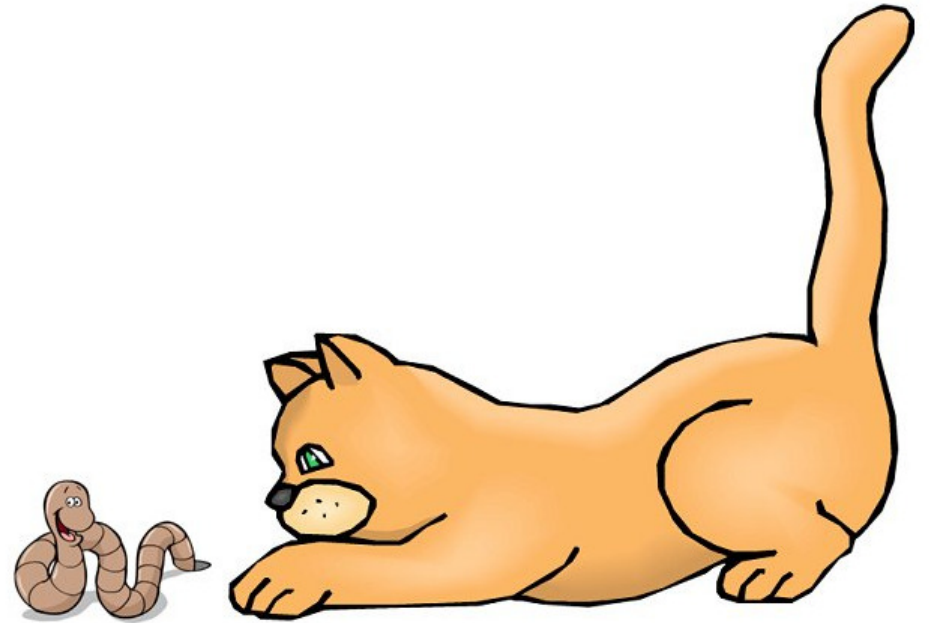
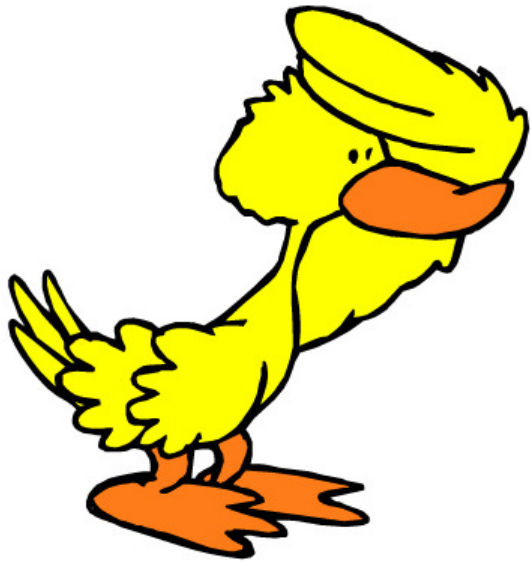
“Oh no, look Callie, is that a caterpillar?” Quacked Danny Duck.

“WHAT! I’m glad I’m not fly! Let’s get out of here!”

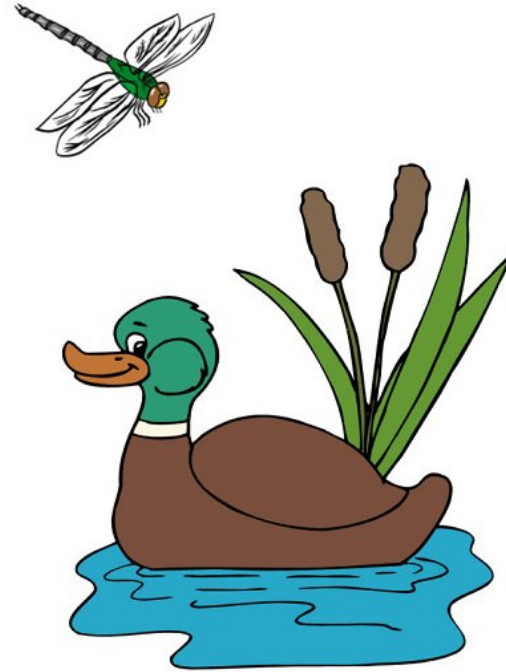
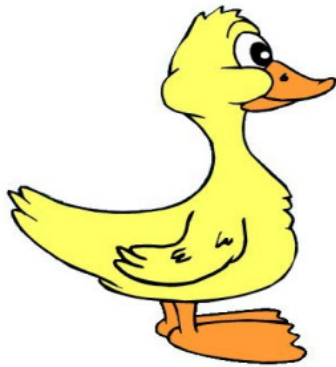


Oh look Callie, is that a caterpillar?" Quacked Danny Duck.

"No! I don't think so, but birds do! I think the cat just wants to play with him!"

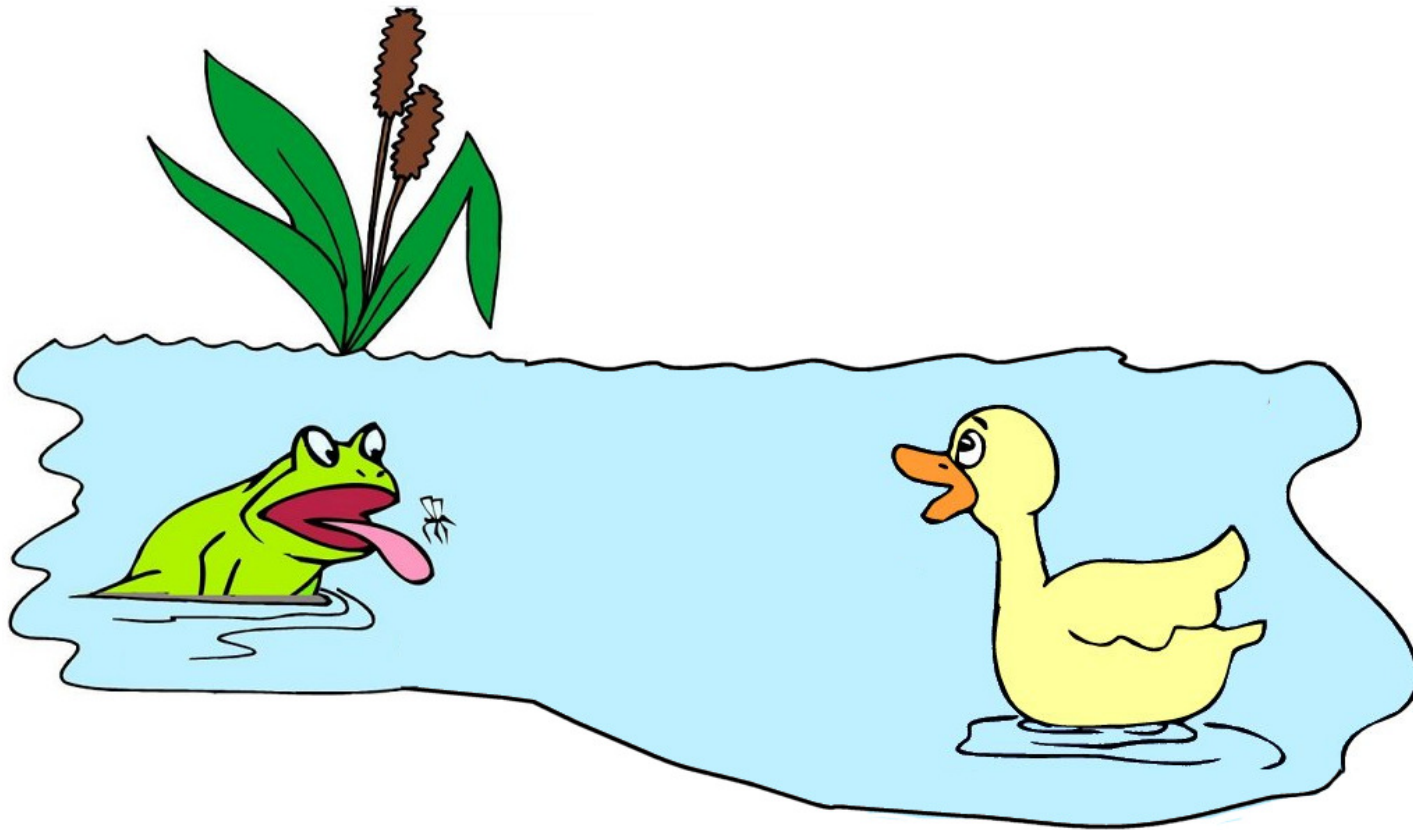


Oh look Callie, is that a caterpillar?" Quacked Danny Duck.

"He's going to grab that mosquito with his long sticky tongue, frogs eat bugs!"

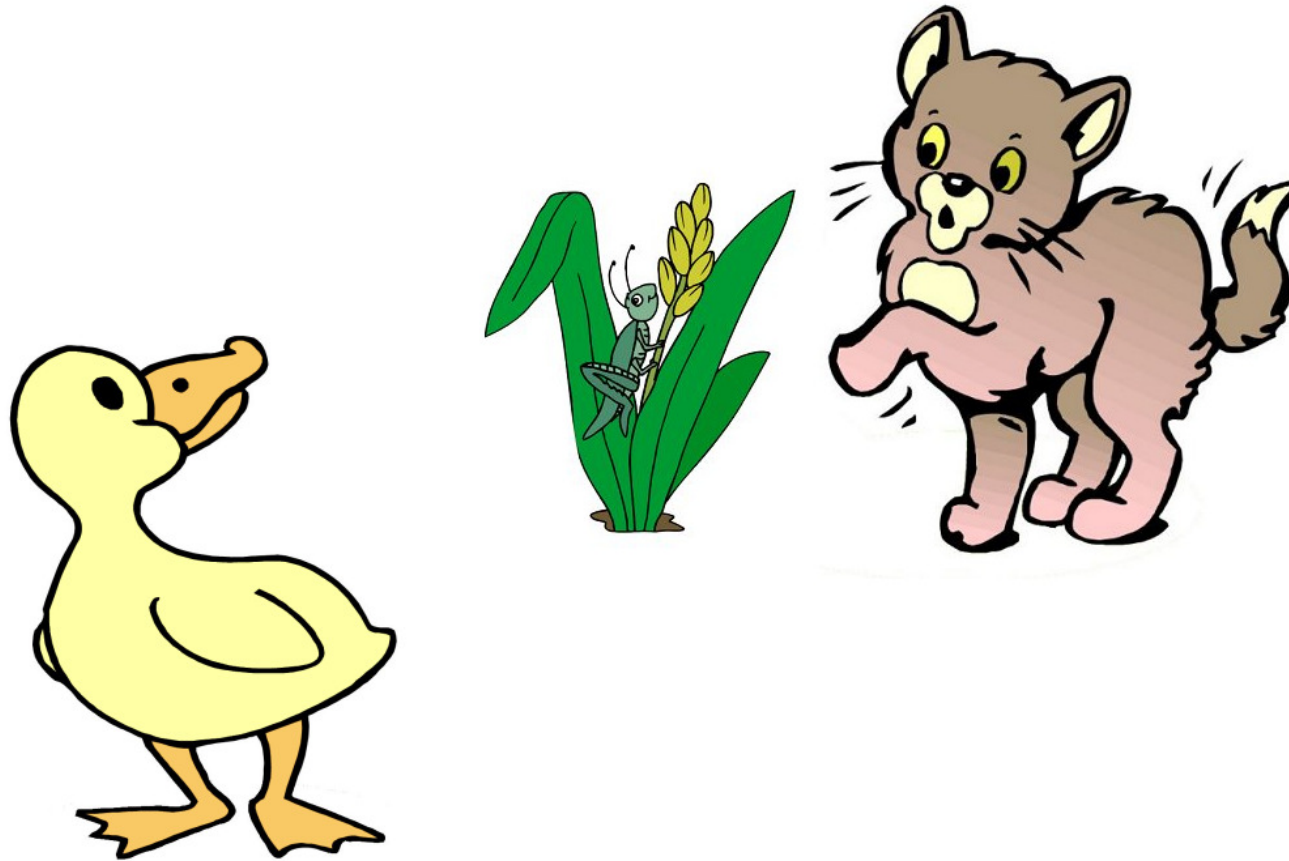


Oh look Callie, is that a caterpillar?" Quacked Danny Duck.

"No, that's not a caterpillar, that's a grasshopper. I think he's getting ready to jump."

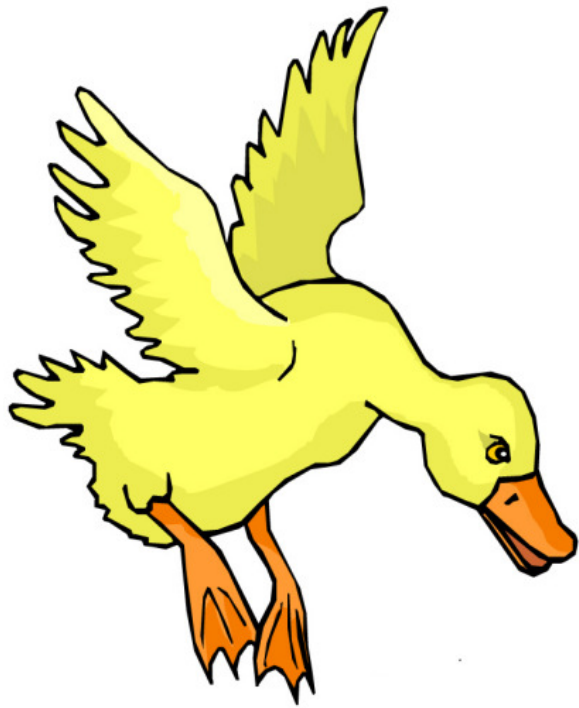


Oh look Callie, is that a caterpillar?" Quacked Danny Duck.

He's making a spider's web, he will catch bugs in his web!"

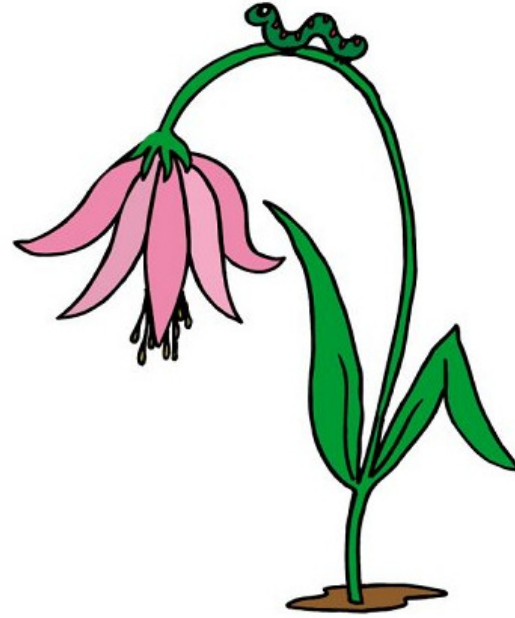
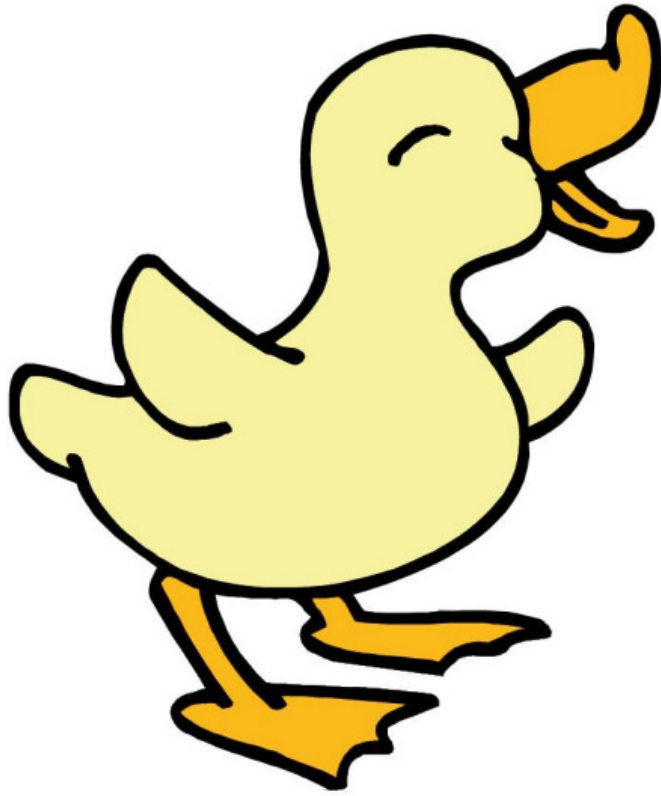


Oh look Callie, are they caterpillars?" Quacked Danny Duck.

They are getting ready to eat, they found some lunch!"

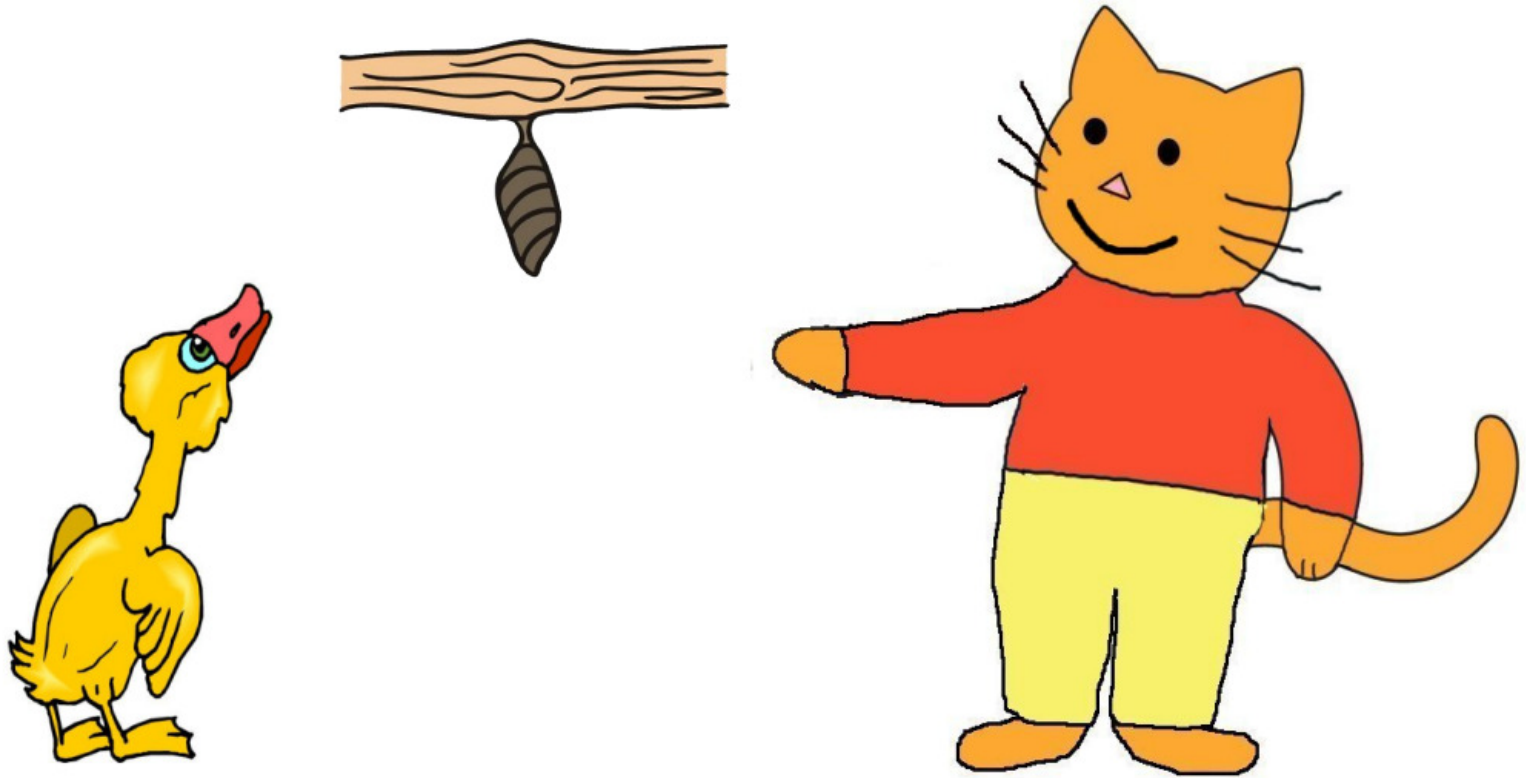


Oh look Callie, are they caterpillars?" Quacked Danny Duck.

No, yucky! I don't eat caterpillars, I am learning about them in preschool."

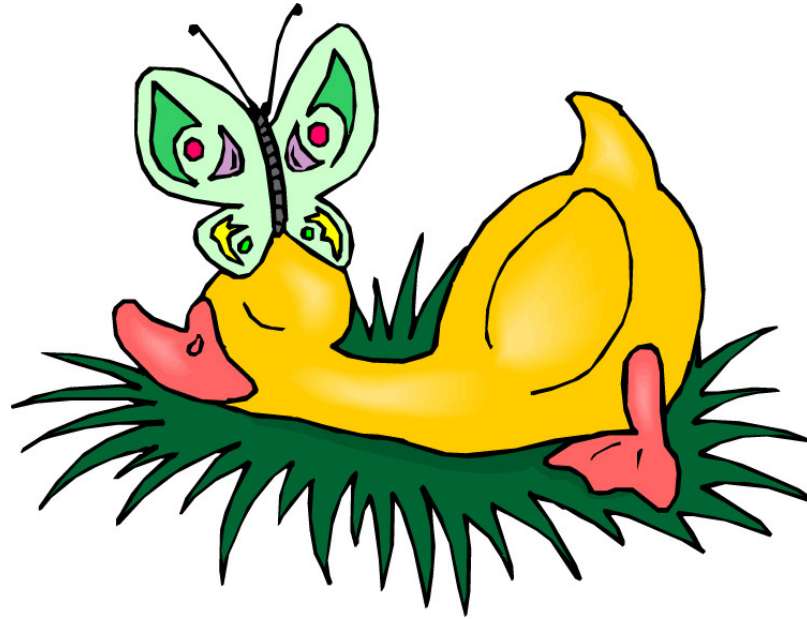


“I learned, that very soon this caterpillar will build a home around himself”

“Why does he do that, is he cold?”

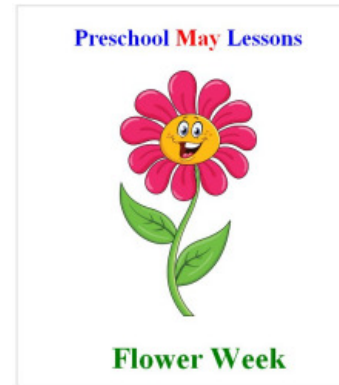
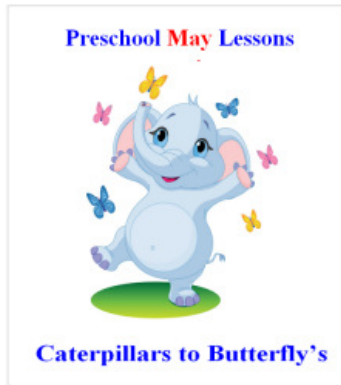
“He does this when he is getting ready to turn into a beautiful butterfly!”
